UPK at Ehills Preschool

- We are offering 10 hours of free pre-k each week for children who are 4 years old on or before October 1st.
- Your child will need to be enrolled in a 4 day Pre-k class or a Jr. Kindergarten class (JK for children that are currently in Pre-K).
- These are 12-hour-per-week classes. Parents will be responsible for the additional 2 hours per week that UPK does not cover.
(Currently \$74 per month)

REGISTERING FOR UPK

- FIRST, YOU WILL REGISTER WITH THE STATE FOR UPK
- NEXT, MAKE SURE WHEN YOU REGISTER ON UPK YOU SELECT THAT YOUR CHILD IS A CURRENT STUDENT IN OUR PROGRAM
- THEN, REGISTER FOR EHILLS PRESCHOOL ON REGISTRATION DAY, beginning January 28th

UPK FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- What if my child is not 4 on October 1st can I still enroll them for a 4 day program at ehills preschool?

Absolutely! Your child will just not qualify for UPK.

- I heard that we can get up to 15 hours of free Pre-K. Is ehills Preschool offering that? **We are not because we are a part-time preschool and do not offer a 15-hour-a week class.**
- What happens if I don't get matched with ehills Preschool?

The UPK system will do its best to match you to your most preferred provider(s). If you are matched with a different provider, you will be able to reject that match. You may need to resubmit your application if you reject the match, depending on when the rejection is completed.
