- ♦ As a young man he experienced reform
- ♦ He then begin to warns Israel of the judgement
- ♦ He was then branded a traitor for the warning

1. The Signal

Jeremiah 6:10-11 (ESV)-To whom shall I speak and give warning, that they may hear?... Therefore I am full of the wrath of the Lord; I am weary of holding it in....Therefore they shall fall among those who fall

2. The Symptoms

Jeremiah 6:10,13-15— behold, the word of the Lord is to them an object of scorn; they take no pleasure in it... “For from the least to the greatest of them, everyone is greedy for unjust gain; and from prophet to priest, everyone deals falsely. They have healed the wound of my people lightly, saying, ‘Peace, peace,’ when there is no peace...they were not at all ashamed; they did not know how to blush.

3. The Solution

Jeremiah 6:16—Thus says the Lord: “Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls.

4. The Stubbornness

Jeremiah 6:16-17— But they said, ‘We will not walk in it.’ I set watchmen over you, saying, ‘Pay attention to the sound of the trumpet!’ But they said, ‘We will not pay attention
