1. The Repetition

Genesis 43:1-2—Now the famine was still severe in the land. So when they had eaten all the grain they had brought from Egypt, their father said to them, “Go back and buy us a little more food.”

2. The Reminder

Genesis 43:3-5— But Judah said to him, “The man warned us solemnly, ‘You will not see my face again unless your brother is with you.’ If you will send our brother along with us, we will go down and buy food for you. But if you will not send him, we will not go down...

3. The Response

Genesis 43:6—Israel asked, “Why did you bring this trouble on me by telling the man you had another brother?”

4. The Responsibility

Genesis 43:8-10— Then Judah said to Israel his father, “Send the boy along with me and we will go at once, so that we and you and our children may live and not die. I myself will guarantee his safety...

5. The Remittance

Genesis 43:11—Then their father Israel said to them, “If it must be, then do this: Put some of the best products of the land in your bags and take them down to the man as a gift...

6. The Response

Genesis 43:14—May God Almighty grant you mercy before the man, and may he send back your other brother and Benjamin. And as for me, if I am bereaved of my children, I am bereaved.”

7. The Reservations

Genesis 43:18— the men were afraid because they were brought to Joseph's house, and they said, “It is because of the money, which was replaced in our sacks the first time, that we are brought in, so that he may assault us...to make us servants and seize our donkeys.”

8. The Reunion

Genesis 43:29—And he lifted up his eyes and saw his brother Benjamin, his mother's son, and said, “Is this your youngest brother, of whom you spoke to me? God be gracious to you, my son!”
