Exodus 3:17—I promise that I will bring you up out of the affliction of Egypt to the land of the Canaanites...And they will listen to your voice

2. The Problem

Exodus 4:1—Then Moses answered, “But behold, they will not believe me or listen to my voice, for they will say, ‘The Lord did not appear to you.’

3. The Power

Exodus 4:2-5— The Lord said to him, “What is that in your hand?” He said, “A staff.” And he said, “Throw it on the ground.” So he threw it on the ground, and it became a serpent, and Moses ran from it. But the Lord said to Moses, “Put out your hand and catch it by the tail”—so he put out his hand and caught it, and it became a staff in his hand that they may believe that the Lord...has appeared to you.

4. The Protest

Exodus 4:10—But Moses said to the Lord, “Oh, my Lord, I am not eloquent, either in the past or since you have spoken to your servant, but I am slow of speech and of tongue.

5. The Providence

Exodus 4:11—Then the Lord said to him, “Who has made man's mouth? Who makes him mute, or deaf, or seeing, or blind? Is it not I, the Lord?...I will help you speak and will teach you what to say.

6. The Plea

Exodus 4:13—But he said, “Oh, my Lord, please send someone else.”
