

It Happened for the Glory of God

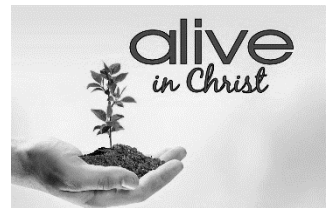
John 11:1-4
