We went to Olympic National Park with some young people and families from the church and it was a hike of approximately 5 hours, we arrived at one of the 4 lakes that are in the mountain, it was a wonderful sight, it was impossible to believe the nature that God created for us with all those landscapes.

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Part of the last days of the second week and the beginning of the third was the VBS that took place at Lake View Church, in which I helped prepare everything from the beginning, decorate, moving chairs and do everything necessary to get the building and classrooms ready.

The VBS lasted 3 days in which I had the privilege of teaching the lesson to 1st & 2nd graders, it was the first time teaching and what better way to do it than in the VBS, without a doubt it was a great stage of learning and of growth. I am looking forward to helping again next year and this time looking forward to participating in even more activities.

In the fourth week of this month, we helped clean and organize the Delano Bay camp, this camp has been part of the church for a few months now, it was vandalized, and the people who broke into the camp did damage of over 1 million dollars, so the church is trying to work little by little to repair everything to reopen the camp, together with other members of the church, we cleaned the gardens, the roof, we repair the surroundings, the cabins and in general cleaning to the whole area.

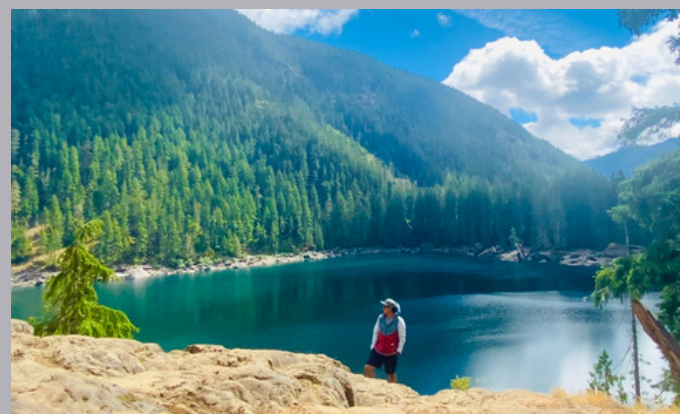
