

Brief information about the Board or Church Leadership Team (CLT)

The Board (CLT) is the congregationally elected board of directors, consisting of at least seven (7) elected church members, who supervise the management of the church's affairs. The officers include, the Board Chair (Moderator), the Vice Chair (Vice-Moderator), plus the remaining five (5) Members-at-Large.

The Board (CLT) is a high level overseeing and policy making body that is in partnership with the Senior minister & Executive minister and provides servant leadership in discerning the direction and goals of First Baptist Church. The Board's (CLT's) primary functions include ensuring that goals and plans are consistent with the call of God on the church and that values, strategies and resources and structures are understandable and used to guide activities and resources of the congregation. In addition, the Board (CLT) is actively involved in approving annual and multi-year plans and major initiatives, providing direction in hiring key leaders, overseeing the financial integrity of the church, and maintaining our denominational affiliations. All this in accordance with FBC Constitution and By-Laws (*link*).

Time Commitment:

The Board meets once per month usually on a Wednesday on Zoom plus two in person meetings per year on Saturday mornings. Members may also be asked to serve on other sub-committees of the Board.
