

2. What in the message did you find interesting, challenging or helpful?
3. The story of Ruth and Boaz is an important portrayal of the work of Christ to redeem us from sin. In the story the guardian-redeemer must 1) be related by blood, 2) be able to pay the redemption price, 3) be willing to redeem, 4) be free himself. Read the following passages. How does Christ meet the requirements to redeem us?

- If you were talking with a 5th grader, based on these passages, how would you summarize why Christ is able to pay for our sin?
