#### Board of Servant Leaders election information

The elections for the Board of Servant Leaders are coming up! Board members serve two-year terms. Those elected this year will join Robert Fekete, Drew Lipman, Deanine Thrash and Laura Blackburn, who are continuing their terms. Here is this year's election timeline:

- January 10 to 17: Nominating committee submits possible candidates to Pastor Johann for review
- January 18 to February 2: Potential candidates contacted
- **February 9:** Proposed slate (with candidate profiles) published
- **February 11 to 23:** Two-week open nomination period.
  - Per GSLC Bylaws (II.c.3) "any member of the congregation may continue to recommend the names of individuals willing to serve on the BoSL along with the individual's personal profile to the nominating committee. Such candidates will be added to the final slate of prospective new BoSL members without prejudice."
- February 25: Final candidate slate published
- February 26 to March 10: Quiet Period for voter reflection on election (two-weeks)
- March 11 to 18: Elections held online

# **Community Service**

Hypothermia Shelter Meals – sign ups still available! An opportunity to serve through supporting the hypothermia shelter meals every Wednesday through the end of March (17 weeks), we prepare and provide hot meals for 25 guests. Would you like to know what it is like to prepare food for the Hypothermia Prevention Program? The best way to think about preparing the food is to consider what you would bring if this were a picnic. You need to provide food in disposable containers and include any needed (sturdy) plates, bowls, cups, napkins, eating utensils. One consideration is that the clients often don't have a full set of teeth - shredded or ground meat is preferable to chunks of meat. The same is true about the fruit. Although there will (usually) be 25 clients at the Fairfax County Hypothermia Shelter, we like to provide enough food to allow second helpings. Plan for roughly 40 meals. South Lakes Food Pantry – continues to serve the community! Since the beginning they have distributed more than 1.5 MILLION POUNDS of food & toiletries to our neighbors in need. What a significant difference you've made in the community with your support of this incredible ministry. Needs are on the rise. We are averaging well over 7,000 pounds (3 ½ tons) of food to families and students in need each week. Please consider shopping from our urgent needs or donating money to the pantry so that they can purchase food for the pantry.
