- **February 11 to 23:** Two-week open nomination period.
- **February 25:** Final candidate slate published
- **February 26 to March 10:** Quiet Period for voter reflection on election (two-weeks)
- March 11 to 18: Elections held online

First Communion for 5th and 6th Graders
