Above & Beyond (A&B) Update—as of February 22

Thanks to everyone who has contributed to the current Above & Beyond program. This year's "wish list "includes 28 items totaling \$300,450 in donation requests. As of February 8, donations totaling \$40,593.87 have fully funded 5 of the 28 items (see list below) and have also partially funded a number of items. A featured request, still open to receive contributions can be found below, and also on our giving page. Please take special prayerful consideration for our featured item, Expanding Operations—Preschool (in bold below).

Above & Beyond (A&B) fully funded items: Workcamp 2024 (Elizabeth City, NC); Senior Youth Ministry; Staff and Core Ministry Celebrations; Choir Needs; Preschool "Big Book" sets; and Direct Mailings.

Above & Beyond (A&B) featured item (not yet fully funded, and remaining balance): Expanding Operations - Preschool: \$6,400.62. This fund provides additional assistance as we begin expanding our operating hours to full-day care with the inclusion of before care, traditional preschool and afternoon care. Funding will specifically cover initial expenses, increased staff requirements and the need to market and share our new program with the community.
