Our program is based on the "Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols," which has taken place every Christmas Eve since 1918 at King's College in Cambridge, England. The history of this service goes back to the Middle Ages. Special observances, such as Christmas, were marked by a series of nine lessons and carols, and later revised for use at King's College.

The scriptural lessons which tell the story of redemption are the main focus of the service. The music and meditations are included to enhance our response to God's Word.

King's College has many traditions, such as the service opening with the Christmas Bidding Prayer and the Lord's Prayer, which we do here at the Evangelical Free Church. We have developed the tradition of singing the hymns "O Come, All Ye Faithful," and "Joy to the World," and we close our service each year with "Silent Night."
