

Dear Brother or Sister in Christ,

Let's begin by praying that each one of us will be a person of prayer; daily, abiding, prayer without ceasing prayer. Pray that we will "pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people" (Ephesians 6:18).

Praise God for all that He's done in and through our church over this past school year. Praise God for Shelly Mustful and Danny Paddock who worked so hard in leading our youth ministry during our search for our next Youth and Young Adults Pastor. Thank God also for Terry Hewitt and Mark Carlson who served with Cru. And praise God for many others who served faithfully in so many ways. Please continue to pray for our search for our next Youth and Young Adults Pastor. We may be getting close – more details coming soon! Please also pray for many of our ministries who are now evaluating this past year's ministry, and carefully considering what needs to be changed or tweaked for next fall. Please also keep our church finances in prayer, as we are currently behind budget.

Please keep our various graduates in your prayers, including our 5th graders who are transitioning to the middle school, as well as our high school and college graduates. Praise God for these milestones! And please pray for clear discernment and direction in what lies ahead. Let's also pray for one another in general as we all switch gears to summer. As Pastor Eric mentioned in this week's Deeply Devoted podcast, "Don't let your discipleship take a summer vacation." Please pray Hebrews 10:23-25 for our church: "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

Please continue to pray for our Strategic Ministry Plan implementation. Our elders met again last Saturday and we're making encouraging progress. We are now in "beta testing" mode for our diagnostic assessment tool. In other words, we are beginning to implement our Strategic Ministry Plan with a few ministries to make sure that our assessment tool is effective and ready, before we launch it comprehensively into every ministry area. Please pray that we'll stay on track with where God has been leading us; that we'll Gather, Grow, Give, and Go for the Gospel! Pray that we'll make any adjustments that may be needed. Pray for our sermons which will cover topics like unity, God's faithful provision, the Lord's Supper, and the danger of deception. Pastor Eric is also preparing a 2-week sermon on the Old Testament minor prophet Joel.
