



## The First Sunday of Advent

READER: Today we begin the season of Advent, a time in which we celebrate the arrival of the incarnate Son of God at the birth of Jesus, and we anticipate the Lord's glorious return at the end of history, when he comes again as judge and savior. On this first Sunday of Advent, the church has traditionally focused on Christ as our HOPE. Join me in professing together from Scripture the hope that we have in Jesus Christ.

READER: 'Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand.

ALL: And we boast in the hope of the glory of God.

READER: Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope.

ALL: And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us." (Rom. 5:1-5, NIV)

READER: As we light our first purple candle today, we begin this season of Advent remembering the Son of God, the hope of the world. He entered into time and space and took on flesh, to save us from our sins and restore us to a right relationship with God our Maker. We also look forward in faith to the glorious return of Christ at the end of the age. Therefore, together we pray in hope:

ALL: "Amen. Come, Lord Jesus." (Rev. 22:20b, NIV)
