The Fourth Sunday of Advent

READER: On this final Sunday of Advent, we light one more purple candle. We reflect on God's LOVE incarnate lying in a manger, who, in the fullness of time would be LOVE incarnate nailed to a cross. "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16, NIV). Join me in reading together the words of Scripture recalling God's great LOVE for us.

READER: 'Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God.

ALL: Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.

READER: This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.

ALL: This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

READER: Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God:

ALL: but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us" (1 John 4:7-12, NIV).

READER: On this fourth Sunday of Advent, we declare, "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!" (1 John 3:1, NIV).
