Sermon-based Discussion Questions

1. What do you remember about the policy of “Don’t ask, Don’t Tell” back in the 1990’s? Would you agree that our society hasn’t always done the best job of helping people who are experiencing same-sex attraction and same-sex behavior? Explain.
2. What are some of the best and worst things that you’ve seen Christians do, in terms of addressing same-sex attraction and same-sex behavior?
3. What advice might you offer someone who is “navigating same-sex attraction” and wants to live a life that honors God? (Consider 1 Corinthians 6:9-11)
4. What advice might you offer a fellow believer who is trying to navigate loving a friend or family member who has chosen same-sex behavior? How do you think we can love and accept the person without approving of sin?
5. What are some of the more helpful resources that you’ve discovered related to same-sex attraction (books, podcasts, sermons, etc.)? What is it about these resources that make them helpful?
6. Pray for people who are experiencing same-sex attraction. Pray that they’ll embrace their identity in Christ and be able to find the help and hope that they need.
