Sermon-based Discussion Questions

1. Can you think of a time when you or someone you know was judged unfairly? What was unfair about it?
2. Romans 2:6 says that “God ‘will repay each person according to what they have done.’” How would it make you feel if this was all that you knew about God?
3. Read Romans 2:6-11. How do you think these verses demonstrate that God does not show favoritism? Are there ever times when you feel like God should show certain people favoritism? Explain.
4. Read Romans 2:12-16. These verses are talking about God’s Old Testament or Mosaic law. In verse 12, why do you think it’s important for us to understand that sin is sin, regardless of how well we know the Bible?
5. How do you think verse 13 might apply to our daily lives? Romans 3:20 gives one perspective, James 1:22 gives another.
6. In verse 16, why might being judged “*through* Jesus Christ” bring us hope? See John 3:16-17.
(Compare this with question #2 above)
