Sermon Notes:

5. Titus 2:12 says that God's grace teaches us. What are some of the things that it teaches us to do and not do? What do you think Titus 2:13 means by "while we wait"?
6. Talk about the ramifications of Titus 2:14. What are some of the outcomes of Jesus giving Himself for us? Why do you think verse 14 mentions the word "eager"?
7. Read Hebrews 10:24. As a Life Group, how can we encourage one another in Christian service? How are you hoping to serve in our church or community this fall?
