


The list...


- 6. Feel a lack of fulfilment in regular tasks, responsibilities and roles?



Telling the difference:

(usually we are escaping boredom, anxiety or responsibility)

Gracious striving Battling diversion /S battling the Flesh, World, and Hell

IT is an awkward, flopping, slippery, bloody, limp-creating, concussion inducing, struggle of constant failure—in the right direction


God has *empowered us* to *forge ourselves* into people of substance
