Jesus' Negative Claim:


You need to pay a lot more attention to what you're working toward

#### John 6:27

Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval." Why did (would) I get in this boat?








## Obedient belief discovers God's pleasing will.

- 7. He gets them there.

(These 7 are just what we are told)










#### What is satisfying?
