Our beliefs determine more than we imagine.






Ellen Langer

Psychologized effect: Mindfulness

Knowing what's going on inside you.

Spiritual Virtue: Humility

Knowing what you are going on inside.



John 6:44

"No-one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day."



There is no faith without humility

Self-interest will never find anything outside the self.

Spiritual Humility

Psychological humility/mindfulness is GOOD, but it isn't enough. Even social humility isn't.

Humility implies looking to what is **morally** and **spiritually** bigger than ourselves.

God's will must surpass mine.

"...If anyone wills God's will, they will find out..."

vs 17

John 7:16 – 17

"Jesus answered, "My teaching is not my own. It comes from him who sent me. If anyone chooses to do God's will, he will find out whether my teaching comes from God or whether I speak on my own."

POINT 2

Truth and righteousness surpass your status.

Humility seeks real glory

John 7:18

"He who speaks on his own does so to gain **glory for himself**, but he who works for the **glory of the one who sent him** is a man of **truth**; there is nothing **unrighteous** in him."

Romans 1:18

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the **godlessness** and **wickedness** of men who **suppress** the truth by their wickedness...

P O 1 N T 3

Honesty surpasses hypocricy and corruption.

Humility abhors hypocricy

John 7:19 Has not Moses given you the law? Yet not one of you keeps the law. Why are you trying to kill me?"

John 7:21 - 24

Jesus said to them, "I did one miracle, and you are all astonished. Yet, because Moses gave you circumcision (though actually it did not come from Moses, but from the patriarchs), you circumcise a child on the Sabbath. Now if a child can be circumcised on the Sabbath so that the law of Moses may not be broken, why are you angry with me for healing the whole man on the Sabbath? Stop judging by mere appearances, and make a right judgment."

Jesus is humble

He lives for the will of the father
He is true and righteous
There is no hypocricy or corruption in him
He is to best possible object of belief



Our problem is deeper than mindfulness.

It is spiritual and moral.

We will suppress the truth in unrighteousness

Unless we accept the self defeating prophesy of the Father.

Believe how?

- 1. Explicitly trust in Jesus in affirmation and confession, Baptism, Lord's table and Fellowship
- 2. Give your attention to God's will First. It's the context for yours.
- 3. Ruthlessly seek the truth and real righteousness.
- 4. Start by opening your mind to your own hypocricy and self righteousness.
- 5. Start with the sins John shows in people
