
LIVING FOR GOD'S GLORY

Implying...

- View your problem from God's perspective, not from the world's perception
- Find God's purpose in the problem than reasoning with the past
- Deal with the problem in God's way by seeking His Glory

- 9:38 Then the man said, "Lord, I believe," and he worshiped him.
- 9:39 Jesus said, "For judgment, I have come into this world, so that the blind will see and those who see will become blind."
