## Genesis 26 A Summary of Isaac's beginnings

- 1-11 famine, a lie, chastening, protection, blessing just as with Abraham.
- 12-13 Jesus related this fact to us.
- 14-15 envy and opposition and persecution as the pagan plugs the wells of Abraham.
- 16 an executive decision for peace.
- 17 Isaac moves a distance away.
- 18 And digs again... where Abraham dug... same well, same name, same promise from God.

  A good lesson: go back to the faithful who went before you.
- 19 And they discovered "living water." The faithfulness of God continued in Isaac 's day....
- 20 But this time, the Canaanites claimed the wells as their own.
- 21 Isaac sought peace...plus he is outnumbered.
- 22 But God continues to guide him. "Rehoboth" "plenty of room" between him and the Philistines.
- 23 ...back home to the place of his childhood Beersheba.
- 24 The promise is repeated.
- 25 An altar is erected. And there at his home. A well is dug.
- 26f. The pagans recognize "Immanuel."
- 32 again!

## Lessons:

- 1. All God's children will be sanctified.
- 2. Truth will continue.
- 3. The Pagan resents the unique place of God's people.
- 4. They plug up the blessings of God.
- 5. And claim the blessings as their own. But we dig again at the wells of Abraham.
- 6. As His people seek peace and move away.
- 7. But God continues, faithful to them in their affliction.
- 8. Hardship can bring you back to your roots.
- 9. But the world is watching and <u>may</u> be converted.
