Sermon Points

1. BACKGROUND: Understanding the General Epistles as a whole
 - a. Books primarily addressing false teaching from WITHIN the Church (see Table 1)
 - b. Books primarily addressing persecution and suffering from OUTSIDE the Church (see Table 2)

Hebrews	1 Peter
Persecution from Jewish sources pressuring conversion back to Judaism	Persecution from Gentile sources pressuring to leave the faith

2. AUTHOR: Peter the Apostle (1:1a)

3. AUDIENCE (1:1b-2)

- a. Relationship to the world: Aliens and Scattered
 - b. Relationship to God: Chosen by the work of each member of the Trinity

1. How is our day and age like the first century world, and how do we experience similar pressures of false teaching and persecution?
2. How is Peter's claim of apostleship encouraging us that his message is true?
3. What do you think most impacted the daily lives of Peter's audience: their scattered, alien relationship to society, or their chosen relationship to members of the Trinity? What should have impacted them the most? How can we focus more on *our* heavenly relationship?
4. What are one or two more things you learned and plan to incorporate from this passage?
