

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Central Sports Football?

Central Sports Football is a Christ-centered football league where we strive for fun, growth, and respect. We want players to have fun while playing, grow as a player throughout the year, and play to win, but not at all costs. We also want the kids to have fun while learning about Jesus in devotionals during practice and before each game, grow in their faith and knowledge of Jesus, and respect the opponent as Jesus teaches us to love others.

When and where is Meet the Team?

Tuesday, August 22nd at the football fields
Kindergarten and below division – 6:00-6:20 pm

1st-3rd Grade division – 6:30-6:50 pm

4th-6th Grade division – 7:00-7:20 pm

When does practice start?

Week of August 28th

When are practices?

Practices are only once per week. Your team will practice on the same field, at the same time, on the same night every week. Times are either 5:30 or 6:30 pm. Some Kindergarten and below teams will have practice times of 6:30-7:30.

When is the first game and last game?

First Game – September 16 Last Game – November 4 (all games are on Saturdays)

Can I request a certain coach?

Unfortunately, due to the number of kids playing we cannot honor coach requests.

When will I know what team, coach, and night of practice my child has?

Our coach trainings are on August 17th and 21st. Coaches will receive their roster before or on that night and should contact you before Meet the Team.

What if I don't hear from my coach before Meet the Team?

You can contact the office and we will let you know, or you can find out at Meet the Team.

What if I can't make Meet the Team, a practice, or a game?

It is ok, just let your coach know.

If I have multiple kids playing, will they be on the same team or on the same night of practice?

If the children are in the same age division, they will be on the same team. We do everything possible to put siblings on the same night for practice.

Are cleats required?

No, but they are recommended

What size ball do they use?

Kindergarten and below – Nerf football 1st -3rd Grade – Nerf football 4th - 6th Grade – Junior size football

What do the players receive?

Jersey, shorts, flag belt, sticker, player armband, Bible, custom football, medal Kindergarten and below receive a flag belt and 1-6th Grade receive an armband.

I was not able to request someone to carpool with when I signed up, what do I do?

Due to the large number of participants, we can no longer guarantee a carpool request and only take it into consideration if the request is a must.

Are pets/animals allowed on the fields?

Central Sports loves animals and family pets but we do not allow them on our fields.

How will I know if practice or games are canceled due to weather?
