Assurance of Fellowship with God


1 John 2:1-6

In 1 John 2:1-6, John gives us three truths that give us assurance that we have fellowship with God.

1. Advocacy (v. 1) - Jesus is our advocate before the Father when we sin
 - Jesus Pleads our cause.
 - Jesus is our righteousness.



2. Atonement (v. 2) - Jesus is our atoning sacrifice
 - God's wrath must be satisfied to have fellowship with God.
3. Allegiance (vv. 3-6) - faithful obedience to God is evidence of knowing him
 - (vv3-4) The person who knows Jesus keeps his commandments.
 - Jesus' sacrifice satisfied God's wrath on our behalf.
 - (v. 5a) The person who keeps Jesus' commandments shows he loves him.
 - Jesus is the only means of atonement for the sins of the world.
 - (v5b-6) The person who loves Jesus walks as he walked.
