1. What does leaving a legacy mean to you personally?
2. Lamech warped Cain's promise of protect in 4:24. In Matt. 18:21-22 Jesus seems to leverage Lamech's words to teach about the necessity of mercy and forgiveness. What can this tell us about how we can cultivate a gospel-legacy?
3. In what spheres of life are you tempted to build a legacy *not* on God. Why those spheres?
4. As disciples of Jesus how can we build a legacy (in career, influence, justice issues, parenting, etc.) on God?
5. How is your walk with God going (fellowshipping with God, going in His direction, and trusting and obeying Him)? Are there specific weaknesses? Share in the Home Group and pray for one another.
6. Are you, by God's grace, being intentional with disciple making and discipleship? Are you pursing someone right now for either? Share in the Home Group and pray for one another.

Genesis 4:17-5:32 reveals 3 legacies that show: a life of lasting significance is built on faith in God and united to Jesus.

The Legacy of Cain (4:17-26)

"Common Grace. The grace of God by which he gives people innumerable blessings that are not part of salvation." – Wayne Grudem

"[God] causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous." – Matt. 5:45

Seth's legacy shows a legacy built on God. His legacy was marked by:

1. **Personal devotion.** Seth had faith in God. He trusted and obeyed God.
2. **Purposeful disciple making & discipleship.** Seth transferred his faith in God to his children, who in turn did the same.
