Isaiah 60 gives a vision for life and ministry that's rooted in seeing the amazing works of God to deliver a people to Himself to bring Him honor and glory.

Seven things God was showing His people in Isaiah 60.

1. How God draws people from every nation and ethnicity to Himself (60:4)
2. How the nations have come to worship the Lord with their heart, soul, mind, and strength (60:5-7)

3. How the miracle of Gentiles coming to worship the Lord is His work (60:8-9)
  4. How His justice is perfect (60:10-12)
  5. How God gives peace and security to His people (60:11, 18)
  6. How the everlasting light of God outshines all other lights (60:19-20)
  7. How the unrighteous are made righteous and thus are secure in Yahweh's land forever (60:21-22)
