Big Idea: We must be led by the Spirit of Jesus Christ, because
Jesus continues his mission through us by the power of His Spirit.

1. Guidance
We must be led by the Spirit of Jesus Christ, because
He provides guidance in an uncertain world.

2. Power
We must be led by the Spirit of Jesus Christ, because
He is powerful over all spiritual and earthly forces.

3. Salvation
We must be led by the Spirit of Jesus Christ, because
He saves in the most unlikely places.

"Led by the Spirit"

Acts 16:6-40

HEAR the Word

"Open my eyes, that I might behold wonderful things out of your law."

-Proverbs 119:18

1. How do you typically think of "being led by the Spirit" playing out in your life? Which of the reasons for doing so resonated with you most?
2. How does the emphasis Luke gives on the Spirit being the Spirit of Jesus Christ help shape our perspective on the way the Spirit ministers to us?

PRACTICE the Word

"...Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock."

-Matthew 7:24

1. Two possible prayers were mentioned: 1) "God, what might you be doing in my life?" 2) "God, how are you going to provide for this situation?" Which of these seems most relevant to your life currently and why?
2. How do you typically respond to uncertainty and adversity? Examples given were: anger, anxiety, ruminating, frustration, questioning. How could you move from one of these responses to prayer and worship? How does Jesus enable you to do so?

RETELL the Word

"Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you..."

-Mark 5:19

1. If you were asked to share the gospel with someone, do you have a simple, clear way to do so? How could you grow in this way?
2. What is one place in your life (live, work, or play) where you have a relationship with someone who it seems like a long shot you could ever be able to share the gospel with them, let alone they become a Christian? How could you add this person into your regular prayer routine, asking the Spirit to work in their heart, lead you, and give you an opportunity?
