Acts 25:1-22

HEAR the Word

“Open my eyes, that I might behold wonderous things out of your law.”

-Psalms 119:18

1. Luke uses the word “favor” several times in this passage suggesting that Paul’s circumstances were both out of his control and unfair. In what ways might we be guilty of short-cutting truth and justice by seeking and offering “favors”?
2. Both this week and last week, we see clearly that Paul was not afraid to die. What are the things of this world that we are tempted to preserve in our lives? How does the preservation of those things sap our courage?

PRACTICE the Word

“...Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.”

-Matthew 7:24

1. In your experience as a follower of Christ, have you ever experienced resistance or injustice as a response to your faith? If so, describe that situation. What was your response?
2. What applications can we take from this passage to apply to our situations of resistance and/or injustice?

RETELL the Word

“Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you...”

-Mark 5:19

1. For Paul the life, death, resurrection, and ascension of Christ was a “game-changer” for everything he believed, said, and did. How is the person of Christ a game-changer for the way you conduct your friendships? Your business? Your family? Your private life?
