Scripture Introduction

- I. The Sovereignty of God (27: 28:1-16, 19)
 - A. Evil Can’t Thwart God’s Plan (v.19)
 - B. God will Providentially meet our Needs (vv.11-16; Rom. 8:28)

HEAR the Word

“Open my eyes, that I might behold wonderous things out of your law.”

-Psalm 119:18

1. What about this passage brings you encouragement? Where do you see God's character displayed?
2. Knowing he would likely receive poor treatment from the Jews, why did Paul continue preaching to that community?

PRACTICE the Word

“...Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.”

-Matthew 7:24

1. Why did Paul “take courage” after receiving fellowship from other Christians in verse 15? How can you cultivate more Christian fellowship in your own life?
2. It is clear from vv.17-28 (and Gal. 5:22-24) that we grow in Christlikeness to the extent we abide in the Word of God. What practices have helped you “abide” in God's Word? Share those practices with your table.

RETELL the Word

“Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you...”

-Mark 5:19

1. Trace the “finger” of God's providence and sovereignty in your life. Take time encouraging your brothers with how God has provided for you.
2. Who are five people you can share the Gospel with this summer?
