We discussed leavened and unleavened bread and how the Israelites didn’t have time to even let their bread rise before they left. They had to hurry! We sampled a loaf of fluffy bread and a piece of flat unleavened bread to see and taste the difference.

We also followed up our story with an activity that had a popsicle stick door on construction paper. We used a tiny bit of red paint and a small brush to “paint” the blood on the door. We reinforced the truth that because there was blood on the doorframe, God’s people were kept safe through the night.
