Theme of Exodus:

The LORD fulfills His promise to Abraham to redeem his offspring from slavery in Egypt through the faithful leadership of his servant Moses and gives instructions for living as His holy people so that He may dwell in their midst.

Purpose:

Moses wrote to tell the story of the Lord's faithfulness to redeem His people from slavery in Egypt and to teach them how to live holy lives so that the glory of God's presence can dwell in their midst...

Aim:

...so that the reader will know the true name and character of the living God and fully trust Him as her Redeemer.
