

#### Chapter 4

<sup>15</sup>Though you, Israel, commit adultery, do not let Judah become guilty. Do not go to Gilgal; do not go up to Beth Aven. And do not swear, "As surely as the Lord lives!" <sup>16</sup>The Israelites are stubborn, like a stubborn heifer. How then can the Lord pasture them like lambs in a meadow?

17 Ephraim is joined to idols; leave him alone!
 18 Even when their drinks are gone, they continue their prostitution; their rulers dearly love shameful ways.
 19 A whirlwind will sweep them away, and their sacrifices will bring them shame.

#### Chapter 5

¹Hear this, you priests! Pay attention, you Israelites! Listen, royal house! This judgment is against you: You have been a snare at Mizpah, a net spread out on Tabor. ²The rebels are knee-deep in slaughter. I will discipline all of them.

<sup>3</sup>I know all about Ephraim; Israel is not hidden from me. Ephraim, you have now turned to prostitution; Israel is corrupt. <sup>4</sup>Their deeds do not permit them to return to their God. A spirit of prostitution is in their heart; they do not acknowledge the Lord.

<sup>5</sup>Israel's arrogance testifies against them; the Israelites, even Ephraim, stumble in their sin; Judah also stumbles with them. <sup>6</sup>When they go with their flocks and herds to seek the Lord, they will not find him; he has withdrawn himself from them. <sup>7</sup>They are unfaithful to the Lord; they give birth to illegitimate children. When they celebrate their New Moon feasts, he will devour their fields

<sup>8</sup>Sound the trumpet in Gibeah, the horn in Ramah. Raise the battle cry in Beth Aven; lead on, Benjamin. <sup>9</sup>Ephraim will be laid waste on the day of reckoning. Among the tribes of Israel I proclaim what is certain. <sup>10</sup>Judah's leaders are like those who move boundary stones. I will pour out my wrath on them like a flood of water. <sup>11</sup>Ephraim is oppressed, trampled in judgment, intent on pursuing idols. <sup>12</sup>I am like a moth to Ephraim, like rot to the people of Judah.

<sup>13</sup>When Ephraim saw his sickness, and Judah his sores, then Ephraim turned to Assyria, and sent to the great king for help. But he is not able to cure you, not able to heal your sores. <sup>14</sup>For I will be like a lion to Ephraim, like a great lion to Judah. I will tear them to pieces and go away; I will carry them off, with no one to rescue them.

<sup>15</sup>Then I will return to my lair until they have borne their guilt and seek my face—in their misery they will earnestly seek me."



## Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Kyle and Claudia: Kyle and Claudia are back in Buenos Aires serving the Lord at their church's Palermo campus after being stateside for a few months. Thankfully, they were able to renew their drivers' licenses, spend time with family and friends, and connect with supporting churches and individuals. Pray that their transition back into ministry rhythms would be quick and that the love of God would shine forth as they teach, counsel, and care for their neighbors and fellow church members. Claudia's father has been diagnosed with cancer and they pray that he might know the Lord as his Savior soon. Pray for La Mision's ministries to the under-resourced, that the Lord would draw people to Himself during this difficult economic time! Finally, pray for their two daughters with them in Buenos Aires and for Isaiah at Covenant College.

**Domestic Missions–One by One Ministries:** One by One Ministries mentors and educates new moms, desiring to see them accept God's love and learn to parent well so that they and their children will thrive. Praise God for a 35 percent increase in the number of moms served last year! Praise God for the completion of their newly revised Mentor Guide with streamlined lesson plans, as well as for the launch of their fully virtual mentoring program that will allow them to serve moms outside of service areas or without transportation. Pray for moms who are overwhelmed with many needs, including depression and emotional difficulties. Ask God to send more mentors.
