Chiastic Structure of John's Prologue

- I. 1:1–5: The Word as God, Agent of Creation, Life, and Light
 - A. 1:6–8: John the Baptist Testifies
 - 1. 1:9: The True Light
 - 1. 1:10–11: Rejected by the World and by His Own
 - 2. 1:12–13: Received by Those Born of God
 - 2. 1:14: The Glory of the Only Begotten from the Father
 - B. 1:15: John the Baptist Testifies
- II. 1:16–18: The Revelation of the Father in the Son
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
