I. God's Grace Through the Fulfillment of Old Testament Prophecy, vs. 24, 28, 36, 37

A. Divided His Garments, vs. 23-24—>Psalm 22:18

“They divide my garments among them,
and for my clothing they cast lots.”

B. Thirst, vs. 28-30—>Psalm 69:21

“For my thirst they gave me sour wine to drink”

—Significance of hyssop, Exodus 12:22

C. No Bones Broken, vs. 33—>Psalm 34:20

“He keeps all His bones; not one of them is broken”

—allusion to Passover lamb, Exodus 12:46

“You shall not break any of its bones”

D. Spear, vs. 34—>Zechariah 12:10

“Whom they have pierced”

II. God's Grace Through the Declaration of "It is Finished", vs. 30

A. "Tetelestai"

B. The Gospel is not just Jesus dying for our sins, but
He also gives us His perfect record

C. Going back to the Garden, Genesis 3...
Christ as Victor over sin, death, and Satan
John 12:31, "now will the ruler of this world be cast out"
He has won! It is finished!

III. God's Grace In the Gift of New Family, vs. 25-27

A. Believers are united as a family like Mary and John/"mother" and "son"

B. Who is present at the foot of the Cross?

Mary the mother of Jesus, Mary the sister of Mary, Mary wife of Clopas,

Mary Magdalene, John "the beloved"

But also the Roman soldiers, the criminals hanging beside Him, the Jewish leaders

C. The Cross is the great equalizer...everyone there ("saint" and "sinner") equally needs to be saved.
