Exodus 15:22-27

Main theme: The LORD sovereignly—and graciously—rules over His people's wilderness journey.

Overarching Theme through Exodus 18:

The LORD who saved His people and set them free from Egyptian slavery will provide everything they need on their wilderness journey to the Promised Land.

Lessons & Truths from Exodus 15:22-27:

2. The LORD tests us to reveal where we are and where we need to grow.
3. We always have a choice in our response.
4. The greatest provision the LORD gives us is Himself. “I AM”
