# Living Out Who We Now Are—Part Two

## Romans 13

I. Submit to Governing Authorities, 1-7

II. Love Your Neighbor as Yourself, 8-10

III. Put on Christ, 11-14

**Main Truth: As a response to God's mercy and in light of the age to come, God's people are commanded to live holy lives as citizens of the state and in all our societal relationships by putting on the Lord Jesus Christ.**

**Aim: Paul's aim in writing this passage is to give his readers (the church in Rome and us today) clear instructions as to how to live as God commands in an unbelieving society, so that He is glorified and that His name is known among the world.**

Sanctification: "the work of God's free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness.", (WCF)

\*the process of growing in our holiness; becoming more and more like Christ

\*a two-fold act: mortification and vivification

Mortification: to put to death sin; putting off the "old self"

Vivification: to put on life/righteousness; putting on the "new self"
