Living Out Who We Now Are—Part Three

Romans 14:1-15:13

Three principles to guide and govern relationships in the Body of Christ:

I. Lordship, 14:1-12

II. Love, 14:13-23

III. Looking to Jesus, 15:1-12

Main Truth: In response to God's mercy, we are to live a life of love and grateful sacrifice in harmony with one another for the glory of God.

Weak in faith: true believer, follower of Christ; conscience not fully matured according to the teaching of Scripture

Strong in faith: true believer, follower of Christ; conscience more matured according to what Scripture teaches

Issues: not for salvation (justification), but for sanctification

Love-Shaped Living in Romans

Agape love: selfless, sacrificial, unconditional love

Romans 5:8, 5; 8:35, 39; 12:9-21; 13:8-10; 14:13-23

–God's love for us, God's love poured into us, God's love flowing through us

**Paul's focus: Agape love is the essence of Christian discipleship.
This will be counter-cultural living.**
