One of the main themes of Romans: The Gospel transforms the lives of everyone who believes.

Main Truth: A Gospel-transformed life is focused on loving and serving God and others.

I. Fulfilling His Call, 15:14-21 (missional)

Prin.: Every Gospel-transformed believer is God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, what we should walk in them.

Ephesians 2:10

II. Uniting Others, 15:22-29

Prin.: Gospel-transformed believers unite to form Gospel partnerships to accomplish the work of His Kingdom.
