

WFW PM 2026 Resolutions

***Only write one or two goals per category: (1) praise; (2) proclamation**

***Bring your goals to our gathering on January 21**

How are you planning to make personal progress this calendar year in:

(1) Partnering with your church family in the mission of **praise** (*corporate worship*)

(2) Partnering with your church family in the mission of **proclamation** (*evangelism; disciple-making*)

Here are some examples of the sorts of goals you might choose to make:

1. Progress in partnering for PRAISE:

- A goal relating to percentage of participation in Sunday corporate worship (such as: commit to participate in Sunday corporate worship 100% in 2026, whether in town at Second or out of town with another church family; 50% of Sunday mornings, arrive to the worship service prior to the musical prelude)
- A goal relating to the manner of participation in Sunday corporate worship (such as: 75% of Sundays, read the sermon text before the service to help prepare my heart; each week, use Sunday's liturgy printed in the bulletin to help shape my prayers)
- A goal relating to Word-filled prayer (such as: read Donald Whitney's *Praying the Bible* and then practice Word-filled prayer once a week by writing out a prayer based on a specific Scripture passage)

2. Progress in partnering for PROCLAMATION:

- A goal for a specific relationship with a non-Christian (such as: aim to engage Sally in evangelistic conversation once a month in 2026, and keep track of how I'm doing in this commitment throughout the year; set aside at least one hour a month in 2026 to time with Sally, and seek opportunities to communicate the gospel when we're together; invite Sally at least five times to corporate worship at Second)
- A specified commitment to pray for non-Christian loved ones (such as: pray for ___ and ___ every Tuesday morning; pray for my non-Christian loved ones every morning; develop a list of five non-Christian neighbors for whom I will pray once a week in 2026)
- Give 5% more to world missions in 2026 than I did in 2025
- Once a week in 2026 retell another person at least one truth about God from my study of God's Word that week
- Contact the World Missions team to be set up with a specific mission partner; then commit to pray for that partner once a week and discover that partner's present joys and challenges in life and ministry
- Memorize one Bible verse a month (the Romans verses!), and look for opportunities that month with a non-Christian friend to retell that verse's truth
