Galatians 5:22-23a, Proverbs 28:20, Luke 16:10 NLT



Being faithful means you can be trusted to do what is expected of you. **When you are a football player, what things should you do faithfully?** (Show up to all practices and games. Show up on time. Show up with a great attitude. Do what is asked of you.) **What good things can happen when you are faithful?** (You might be put in charge of something. You might be rewarded in some way.)
