



FUNERAL SERVICE TEAM

The Funeral Service Team serves the church and those who have suffered a loss by helping set up, serve food, and clean up funeral luncheons on Saturdays, as the need arises. A call is made during the week to team members, mobilizing teams for each shift on the day of the service. Tasks include decorating tables, plating desserts, preparing beverages and table service, receiving the catered meal, serving the meal, cleaning up, and providing compassionate care for the family and guests.

GIFTING & STRENGTHS
