

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

How Great is Our God

Psalm 36

Additional passages: See below, attached to each main point.

Introduction: John started by presenting a backdrop for our lives of the greatness of our God. God is unmatched in splendor and power, unequaled in wisdom and sound judgment, and perfect and personal in His fatherly, covenant-keeping love for His people. We can always call out to Him!

Questions:

Contrast Him to humans: (Psalm 36:1-4, also Num 23:19, Rom 11:33-36).

1. Think about how you have experienced the wickedness and fickle nature of people in your life and similar failings in you towards others. How has the goodness and character of God stood out in contrast?

Compare Him to visible glory: (Psalm 36:5-6, also Ps 19:1-6, Ps 29, Matt 6:25-33).

2. What aspects of creation make you think of God and say "Wow, wow, wow?"
3. When is a moment in your life when you remember being awestruck by God?

Consider His loyal love: (Psalm 36:7-9, also John 3:16, Romans 5:8, Romans 8:32, 1 John 3:1-3).

4. Do you believe day-in and day-out that God loves you? What do your attitude and actions look like when you are trusting that He loves you?
5. David describes God's love as being precious to him, which John noted can only be true if it is personally meaningful to us. Do you view God's love this way? How has God shown His love to you personally?
6. How is it going with being generous in your hospitality to others? With regularly opening your home and being generous with food and resources when you invite people in?

Call for His Help: (Psalm 36:10-11, also Philippians 4:6-7, John 15:7, 1 John 5:14-15).

7. How is it going with maintaining a regular rhythm of prayer in your life?
8. How do you think God wants your life to change based on this sermon and discussion?
