

Redeemer's Embrace Grace Group Volunteer Wishlist

1. Help lead an Embrace Grace 12 week semester:
Time commitment includes Thursdays from 5p-9p on site at Redeemer, plus planning time outside of each weekly group and time spent building relationships with attending moms (ie. Texting, possibly meeting one on one outside of group time)
2. Help lead an Embrace Life group (2 ten week semesters)
Time commitment would be similar to leading an Embrace Grace group. See #1 above.
Embrace Life is the follow-up ministry to Embrace Grace for moms once their babies are born. Redeemer does not currently have this ministry going. We have pastoral approval, we need leaders. Day and time TBD.
3. Coordinate childcare for Princess Day and/or the Baby Shower
Can be done mostly at home. Find and confirm at least 2 childcare workers per event. Make sure childcare workers are background checked. Communicate with Embrace Grace leaders.
4. Coordinate the details for the Princess Day event, includes contacting vendors, food providers, set-up/clean up team
Can be done mostly from home. Contact and confirm availability of vendors for the event. Communicate with Embrace Grace leaders. A list of previous and current vendors will be provided as a starting point.
5. Organize Table Leaders for the Baby Shower (similar to Table Hosts at Redeemer Women events to ask questions, help moms & their guest feel comfortable and welcome at the event)
Contact Life Groups to find women to attend serve as Table Hosts for the EG Baby Shower. Write up and provide a copy of several questions that the Table Hosts can ask attending moms & their guests during the event. The goal is to have the same number of Table Hosts as EG moms attending the event.
6. Help organize a meal or two for each EG mom after their baby is born
Can be done mostly at home. Could involve contacting Life Groups, setting up "Meal Trains," or gathering gift cards. We usually have about 10 moms per semester who live within a 35 minute radius of Redeemer.
7. Help with decorating for special events (Princess Day and/or Baby Shower)
On site day of the event(s). Gather/acquire decorations (costs can be reimbursed within reason), set up and collect items afterward. Communicate with EG leaders.
8. Women with a "mothering specialty" to present to the class during part of 1 night's session to share about their specialty. For example: Doula, midwife, lactation consultant.
9. Women who have been single moms to share their testimony to the class during part of 1 night's session. This helps give hope to attendees!
10. Help with Baby Shower Thank You cards. Can be done at home. Help address envelopes (address & return address). Can be close to 50 envelopes. EG leaders provide envelopes and addresses.
