

HOW TO PARTICIPATE, AND WHAT TO RECYCLE IN THIS PROGRAM

We are collecting many different things for recycling! To participate please bag the following items separately by category. When possible, bring them in paper bags, old bread bags, or some other pre-used plastic packaging.

Category 1: Britta filters, pitchers dispensers, bottles, faucet systems and packaging

Category 2: Flexible plastic packaging with the following labels— Kroger, Private Selection, Simple Truth, Simple Truth Organic, Roundy's, Comforts products, Luvsome pet products and other Kroger Company brands (These items can also be found in other Kroger owned stores...Pick 'n Save and Metro Market.)

Category 3: Pouches and caps from squeezable fruit and veggie snacks, (i.e. "GoGo Squeez")

Category 4: Aluminum and plastic drink pouches and straws, (NO drink boxes)

Category 5: Markers and pens that no longer work

Category 6: Old toothbrushes, toothbrush packaging, empty toothpaste tubes, dental floss containers, the heads of electric toothbrushes, bar soap wrappers, empty deodorant containers

Category 7: Non-recyclable parts from containers of any brand cleaning products, (pumps, caps, triggers and soft pouches)

Category 8: Used up plastic gift cards or expired credit cards. (Cut up any cards that have personal information on them)

Category 9: "Late July Snacks" bags

Category 10: Any brand of coffee bags

Category 11: "Little Bites" snack bags

Category 12: Styrofoam packing, Styrofoam egg cartons and CLEAN meat trays NO PACKAGING PEANUTS (These items can also be dropped off at Reynolds Urethan Recycling at 2701 Progress Rd.)

Category 13: Arm & Hammer and Oxyclean pouches

Category 14: Inner linings of cereal boxes, plastic grocery bags, bread bags, case overwraps, dry cleaning bags, newspaper sleeves, ice bags, plastic resealable bags, produce bags, bubble wrap, salt bags. Please note, many of these items can also be dropped off at retail grocery stores.)

Category 15: NEW— Any brand and prescription contact lenses and related plastic film, pods, and cardboard packaging

Category 16: NEW—"Bare Naked" granola bags and bites

Category 17: NEW—Candy wrappers and packaging

Category 18: NEW—Granola bar wrappers and single serving size snack bags

Category 19: NEW—Crayons, pencils and glue sticks

Items sent to Lions Club: Any prescription eye glasses & sunglasses, and any brand of non-prescription eye glass and sunglass cases

DROP-OFF LOCATIONS & INSTRUCTIONS

All items may be dropped off at First United Methodist Church, 203 Wisconsin Avenue in Madison. Please bring your items on Sunday mornings, (9:00—noon), or Monday thru Thursday from 9:00 a.m.—2:00 p.m. (If the door is locked, please ring the bell.) It is suggested that you call the church in advance to be sure someone can let you in. First Church's phone number is 608-256-9061. DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS UNATTENDED AT THE FRONT DOOR OF THE CHURCH.

Items in categories 1-7 may be dropped off at Monona Public Library, 1000 Nichols Street. This does not include films, (i.e. grocery bags, packaging, etc.). Look for green bins located outside the Nichols Street entrance.
