

Dear Central UMC Family,

What a joy it has been to be at Central these past few months. We cannot help but marvel at the healing and hope experienced daily. Every week, we learn of people coming back to our church and even back to their faith as they hear the simple and profound message: *Jesus loves you. It's not complicated*.

Since the summer, we have had new discipleship and small groups emerge. We've multiplied children and youth Sunday school classes. We've welcomed 38 new members into our congregation, and we continue to feed 100+ individuals each Tuesday and Thursday through our community meals ministry. We are showing and sharing Jesus in so many transformative ways. Our ministers and lay leadership have done an exceptional job of growing our church, bringing new people to Christ, and continuing our great work in the community.

Our impact for the kingdom of Christ has not stopped during this season; in fact, it has not even stuttered. These ministries and missions survive and thrive thanks to your financial generosity. As we prepare for the final quarter of the year, we wanted to provide you with a thorough review of the church's financial position.

Our giving trends since July 1 would have us receiving between \$350,000 and \$400,000 for the last quarter of 2023. In order to fully fund the ministries and mission work discussed above, we need to raise \$750,000. This means that we must raise an additional \$350,000 to \$400,000 in new or increased gifts.

We are delighted to share with you that a number of members (including church staff) have committed nearly \$175,000 to help us reach our \$400,000 target in new or increased gifts. We are confident that we will receive the funding we need so we can continue the good work God has begun in our community. Together, we can do this!

These last few months would not have been possible without your faithfulness. You are cheerful givers who are both blessed and a blessing.
