**Rick Bergstrom** trusted Christ as his personal Savior at the age of 18 while attending Forest Home Christian Camp. Years later Rick and Karen realized that Karen had also attended Forest Home during that same weekend and was praying for his salvation even though she had not yet met him. He has been a member of Calvary since 1982.
