Event Details Questions

Q: Where can I find information about this event online?

Q: Where is this event happening?

A: Calvary Church of Santa Ana, 1010 N. Tustin Ave, Santa Ana, CA 92705

Q: When is this event happening?

A: Saturday, March 14, 2026

Q: What time is the show?

A: The show starts at 7 pm.

Q: What time do the doors open?

A: There are a couple different door times.

- 6:30 pm – General Admission doors open
- 6:15 pm – Early Admission/VIP doors open

Q: Will there be an intermission?

A: Yes, the intermission will be approximately 1 hour into the event and last for approximately 15 minutes.

Ticketing Questions

Q: Where do I purchase tickets?

A: Visit CalvaryLife.org/funny and click “Get Tickets Now” to be directed to Michael, Jr.’s ticketing website.

Q: Can I buy tickets in person at Calvary Church?

A: No, there are no on-site advance ticket sales.

Q: Can I buy tickets at the door?

A: This event is likely to sell out well in advance. It is strongly recommended to purchase tickets in advance.

Q: I’m having a problem with the tickets I purchased or am trying to purchase online. Who can help me?

A: Event ticketing is handled by EventBrite. Start at EventBrite.com/help. There are several contact options for getting in touch with Customer Support.

Parking Questions

Q: Where do I park?

A: Calvary has parking on both the north and south sides of campus. From Tustin Ave, turn west on either Wellington Avenue or Fruit Street and look for the Calvary Parking signs. There will be overflow parking at a neighboring lot across Wellington Avenue.

Q: Is there anywhere I SHOULDN’T park?

A: Do not park in the small Calvary Christian School lot on Tustin Avenue, located between Fruit Street and Wellington Avenue. You will not be able to access campus from this lot.

Do not park in the Heritage Building lot, located just east of the Wellington Street parking lot.

Q: Where should I park for handicap access?

A: There will be handicap parking in the Wellington Street parking lot. See the parking attendant for assistance in locating the designated spaces, if needed. The north side of campus is the easiest to access for those wishing to use a ramp rather than stairs.

Q: Someone in my party would benefit from being dropped off near an entrance. Where should I go?

A: In the Wellington Avenue parking lot, use the loading zone at the main campus entrance near the Worship Center building. Please pull fully into the loading zone to facilitate continued traffic flow. There will be volunteers at the entrance to provide assistance as needed while you park.

In the Fruit Street parking lot, pull up to the curb near the flag pole. Please keep your vehicle as close to the curb as possible to facilitate continued traffic flow. There will be volunteers at the entrance to provide assistance as needed while you park.

Food/Concessions Questions

Q: Will there be a meal served at this event?

A: No, there will not be a publicly available dining option on campus. Please plan to have dinner prior to attending. There are numerous dining options within 5 minutes of campus, with the closest hub of options in The Centre on 17th Street, located at 2000 17th Street, Santa Ana, CA 92705.

Q: Will there be concessions available?

A: Yes, Calvary Christian School's middle school mission team will be selling pre-packaged snack items, drinks, and coffee on the central Patio. They are raising funds for their trip to serve in Costa Rica over their spring break. Learn more about this trip at CalvaryLife.org/trips and more about Calvary Christian School at ccschool.org.

Q: What food/drink may I bring with me into the Worship Center?

A: You may bring water in a closed container into the Worship Center. No food or drink will be allowed inside.

Volunteering Questions

Q: I would like to help at the event. How do I sign up?

A: Visit CalvaryLife.org/Funny and click on the Volunteer Here button. Complete the registration form, and we will be in touch with final details in the couple weeks before the event.

Q: I want to volunteer, but I need to know what the time commitment is.

A: Volunteers will be asked to arrive by 5 pm for a brief training and assigning volunteer placements. Depending on the role you are in, you could be need up to one hour after the show ends. The show will end approximately 9 pm.

Q: If I volunteer, may I watch the show for free?

A: Yes, you will be able to watch some or most of the show, as the responsibilities of your role allow.

Q: Will volunteers be fed dinner?

A: You will receive a concessions voucher to use at the CCS concessions stand on the Patio. The offerings will be light pre-packaged snacks, so you should plan to have dinner in advance.
