Rooted in the Sermon on the Mount - Hashtag Blessed or Gospel Blessed

Matthew 5:3-6

Questions to help the family dive deeper into the sermon!

1. What does it mean to be blessed?
2. Why are we blessed this way? Is being/feeling blessed a temporary thing?
3. What does it mean to be "poor in spirit", and why does Jesus say that the "kingdom of heaven is theirs"?
4. What does it look like to really mourn over sin, and how are we comforted?
5. What does it mean to be humble in the way Jesus is talking about?
6. How are we supposed to "hunger and thirst after righteousness"? What kind of righteousness do we long for? How are these people blessed?
7. What is the difference between the normal way people say they're blessed (#blessed) and the way Christians use the word (Gospel Blessed)?
8. There are no action verbs in these verses... so, what are we supposed to do to be blessed?
9. How is being blessed similar to rest?
10. What is our response to these beatitudes?
